Part 2: Jazz standards, popular and original music Spartacus, New Cinema Paradise, etc. will be performed. *In the first part of the concert, there will be a performance with dimmed lights.

*The performance will be tailored to the atmosphere of the venue on the day of the event. Therefore, the music is subject to change.

Karuizawa Ohga Hall and its special piano "Steinway D.274 Michelangeli"

The concert hall was donated to the town of Karuizawa in 2004 by Norio Ohga, former honorary chairman of Sony Corporation, who was an active musician. The pentagonal surround system was developed in pursuit of an acoustical ideal. Many recordings have been made here. Maximum capacity is 750. * Excluding standing room and choir seats. The performance will be given on the "Hamburg Steinway Concert Grand Piano D274," which Arturo Beneditti Michelangeli, one of the most famous pianists of the 20th century, brought and played when he visited Japan. Please enjoy the performance on the piano chosen by Michelangeli, who is said to have been uncompromising.

Access from Tokyo: 150 km by car or take the Hokuriku Shinkansen from Tokyo Station to Karuizawa Station. *About 70 minutes; the unreserved seat fare is about 5,500 yen.

Yuki Arimasa profile

The Boston Herald said, "Yuki Arimasa is a sensitive accompanist and expressive, imaginative soloist." He has performed with Roy Haynes and nine-time Grammy Award-nominated jazz vocalist Tierney Sutton, as well as at jazz festivals and live music venues in Japan and abroad. Born in Tokyo in 1961, he started piano lessons at the age of 3. His passion for jazz ignited at the age of 12 when he was captivated by a performance from pianist Oscar Peterson. He graduated with a degree in composition and arranging from the Berklee College of Music in the U.S., From improvisations of Bach and Debussy to jazz standards



where he later served as an assistant professor of piano for eight years. Arimasa returned to Japan in 1996. Currently, he is a professor and vice-chairman of the Jazz and American Music Course at Senzoku Gakuen College of Music. In 2016, he established Artist Green as a general incorporated association to promote the arts, including communication among musicians from different countries and educational workshops. He also focuses on mentoring younger musicians and serves as a judge for international jazz competitions (Montreux Jazz Festival Japan, Singapore Jazz Competition, etc.).
